



## SSSSC Travel Fellowships for Student & Postdoc Members

The Swiss Society for Sleep Research, Sleep Medicine and Chronobiology (SSSSC) offers travel fellowships for its student and junior postdoc members to attend the congress of the European Sleep Research Society (ESRS), which takes place every other year. These fellowships will be available for the first time for the ESRS congress 2006 in Innsbruck.

### General rules

The board of the SSSSC decides on a two-year basis about the number of awards to be offered and the amount awarded. This information will be posted on the SSSSC website and announced in a letter to the SSSSC members at least one month prior to the deadline for abstract submission.

1. The SSSSC offers travel fellowships to attend the ESRS meeting for its student members working towards a doctoral degree and junior postdoc members.
2. The board of the SSSSC decides on a two-year basis about the number of awards to be offered and the amount awarded.
3. To apply for a fellowship, student members and postdocs should submit a copy of their abstract in which they are indicated as first author. A letter of motivation, a letter of recommendation signed by their supervisor, and a curriculum vitae must be included.
4. The selection of abstracts to be awarded will be made by a group of members of the SSSSC designated by the Board of the Society. Selection will be based on scientific excellence.
5. All applicants will be informed in writing.
6. Applicants applying for a travel fellowship are requested to declare all other financial support they might receive for attendance of the same congress.
